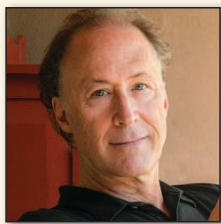
A Wine Country Weekend Like No Other

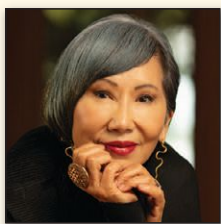

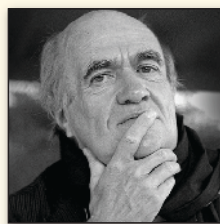
